## Temporary Northbound and Southbound Lane Closure on the 2700, 2800, and 2900, Blocks of 2<sup>nd</sup> Street, SE, For DC PLUG Feeder 15166 Begins May 1-31, 2024.

**(WASHINGTON, DC)** – The District Department of Transportation (DDOT) advises stakeholders to expect delays due to upcoming lane closures to install manholes and conduits on **the 2700, 2800, and 2900 blocks of 2<sup>nd</sup> Street, SE between Newcombe Street, SW, and Malcolm X Avenue, SE**. All residents will keep access to their homes. Please adhere to all NO Parking signs.

The lane closure is estimated to last 4 weeks to install manholes and conduits (weather permitting). The installation of manholes and conduits is necessary to complete the DC PLUG initiative's Feeder 15166 project which consists of undergrounding powerlines for a more resilient DC.
