Road Closure

From 14th Street and Montana Avenue, NE, to 14th Street and Saratoga Avenue, NE.

Beginning August 10th, through August 11th, 2023.

(WASHINGTON, DC) – The District Department of Transportation (DDOT) is advising stakeholders to expect Road Closure due to conduit and manhole installation weather permitting. Parking will be restricted. Please adhere to all No Parking signs.

- **Beginning August 10th through August 11, 2023, from 9:00am 5:00pm Road Closure. We apologize for the inconvenience of this short notice. The street will be reopened by COB on August 11, 2023.**

The road closure is necessary to complete the DC PLUG initiative's Feeder 14008 project conduit and manhole installation. The DC PLUG Initiative consists of undergrounding powerlines for a more resilient DC.
