Temporary Road Closure from the 200, 400, and 500 Blocks of Newcomb Street, SE, and the 2900 block of 4th Street, SE For DC PLUG Feeder 15166 Begins July 9-19, 2024.

(WASHINGTON, DC) – The District Department of Transportation (DDOT) advises stakeholders to expect delays due to the upcoming road closure for the final restoration of Milling and Paving on the **200, 400, and 500 blocks of Newcomb Street, SE, and the 2900 block of 4th Street, SE**. All residents will keep access to their homes. Please adhere to all NO Parking signs.

- **200 block of Newcomb Street, SE between 2nd and 4th Street, SE**
- **400 and 500 blocks of Newcomb Street, SE between 4th and Malcolm X, Avenue, SE**
- **2900 block of 4th Street, SE between Mellon Street, SW, and Oakwood Street, SE**

The road closure is estimated to last 2 weeks for the final restoration (weather permitting). The restoration is necessary to complete the DC PLUG initiative's Feeder 15166 project which consists of undergrounding powerlines for a more resilient DC.
