Roadway Concrete Base Repair

5th Street from Van Buren Street to Aspen Street, NW

Beginning July 10th through July 22, 2023, daily for 24hrs/7days per week

(WASHINGTON, DC) – The District Department of Transportation (DDOT) is advising stakeholders to expect Lane Shifts, 24/7 due to roadway concrete base repair weather permitting. All residents will keep access to their homes. Please adhere to all No Parking signs.

Beginning July 10th through July 22, 2023, Lane shift will be implemented daily for 24hs/7 days per week on 5th Street NW from Van Buren Street to Aspen Street.

The Lane Shifts are necessary to complete the DC PLUG initiative's Feeder 15009 project roadway concrete base repair. The DC PLUG Initiative consists of undergrounding powerlines for a more resilient DC.
