## Roadway Concrete Base Repair

### 5<sup>th</sup> Street from Van Buren Street to Aspen Street, NW

**Beginning July 10th through July 22, 2023, daily for 24hrs/7days per week**

**(WASHINGTON, DC)** – The District Department of Transportation (DDOT) is advising stakeholders to expect Lane Shifts, 24/7 due to roadway concrete base repair weather permitting. All residents will keep access to their homes. Please adhere to all No Parking signs.

- **Beginning July 10<sup>th</sup> through July 22, 2023, Lane shift will be implemented daily for 24hs/7 days per week on 5<sup>th</sup> Street NW from Van Buren Street to Aspen Street.**

The Lane Shifts are necessary to complete the DC PLUG initiative's Feeder 15009 project roadway concrete base repair. The DC PLUG Initiative consists of undergrounding powerlines for a more resilient DC.
