Temporary Westbound and Eastbound Lane, and Sidewalk Closure in the Unit block, 200 to 500 Blocks of Malcolm X Avenue, SE, For DC PLUG Feeder 15166 Begins June 10, 2024, to July 10, 2024

(WASHINGTON, DC) – The District Department of Transportation (DDOT) advises stakeholders to expect delays due to upcoming lane and sidewalk closures to install manholes, tapholes, and conduits in the **Unit block and the 200 to 500, block of Malcolm X, Avenue, SE, between Martin Luther King Jr., Avenue and the 295 Ramp SE**, Weather permitting). Installation of manholes, Tapholes, and conduits which is necessary to complete the DC PLUG initiative’s Feeder 15166 project which consists of undergrounding powerlines for a more resilient DC.
