## Temporary Northbound and Southbound Lane Closures from the 2800 to 2900 Blocks of 2nd Street, SE For DC PLUG Feeder 15166 Begins August 11, 2024, to September 11, 2024

**(WASHINGTON, DC)** – The District Department of Transportation (DDOT) advises stakeholders to expect delays due to upcoming northbound and southbound lane closures to install manholes and conduits and asphalt base restoration on the **2800 to 2900 blocks of 2nd Street, SE between Newcombe Street, SW and Malcolm X Avenue, SE** (weather permitting). The installation of manholes, conduits and asphalt base restoration is necessary to complete the DC PLUG initiative's Feeder 15166 project consisting of undergrounding powerlines for a more resilient DC.

The lane closures are estimated to last 4 weeks to install manholes and conduits (weather permitting).
