Temporary Northbound Lane Closure from the 200 and 400 Blocks of Orange Street, SE, For DC PLUG Feeder 15166, from September 14, 2024, to September 27, 2024.

(WASHINGTON, DC) – The District Department of Transportation (DDOT) advises stakeholders to expect delays due to the upcoming northbound lane closure for landscaping and pavement marking on the **200 and 400 blocks of Orange Street, SE between 2nd Street, NE, and 5th Street, SE** (weather permitting).

The lane closure for the landscaping and pavement markings is estimated to last **2 weeks** (weather permitting). This work is necessary to complete the DC PLUG initiative's Feeder 15166 project which consists of undergrounding powerlines for a more resilient DC.
