Temporary Westbound and Eastbound Lane Closure from the 200, 400, and 500 Blocks of Oakwood Street, SE, For DC PLUG Feeder 15166 Begins June 6, 2024, to July 6, 2024.

(WASHINGTON, DC) – The District Department of Transportation (DDOT) advises stakeholders to expect delays due to upcoming lane closures to install manhole Recess, conduits, and Asphalt Base on the **200, 400, and 500 blocks of Oakwood Street, SE between 2nd Street and Malcolm X Avenue, SE**. All residents will keep access to their homes. Please adhere to all NO Parking signs.

The lane closure is estimated to last 4 weeks to install manhole Recess, conduits, and Asphalt base (weather permitting). The installation of manholes and conduits is necessary to complete the DC PLUG initiative's Feeder 15166 project which consists of undergrounding powerlines for a more resilient DC.
