Temporary Northbound Lane Closures from the 3000 Block of 4th Street, SE For DC PLUG Feeder 15166 Begins July 10, 2024, to August 10, 2024.

(WASHINGTON, DC) – The District Department of Transportation (DDOT) advises stakeholders to expect delays due to upcoming lane closures to install manhole Recess, conduits, and Asphalt base restoration on the **3000 block of 4th Street, SE between Orange Street, and Oakwood Street, SE** (Weather permitting). The installation of manholes Recess, conduits and Asphalt base restoration is necessary to complete the DC PLUG initiative's Feeder 15166 project which consists of undergrounding powerlines for a more resilient DC.

The lane closures are estimated to last 4 weeks to install manhole Recess, conduits and Asphalt base restoration (weather permitting).
