Short-term Road Closures and Detours

6700 block of 5th Street NW – May 10, 2023

6600 block of 5th Street NW – May 18, 2023

9:30 am to 3:00 pm

(Washington, DC) – The District Department of Transportation (DDOT) is advising stakeholders to expect the following short-term road closures and detours, weather permitting:

- **On May 10, 2023 - 6700 block of 5th Street NW between Aspen Street and Whittier Street NW**
- **On May 18, 2023 - 6600 block of 5th Street NW between Whittier Street NW and Van Buren between 9:30 am to 3:00 pm**

These short-term lane closures are necessary to complete the DC PLUG initiative’s Feeder 15009 project which consists of undergrounding powerlines for a more resilient DC.

Local residents will still have access to their properties.
