D.C. PLUG Feeder 00368 - Weekly Lane Closures March 28 through April 11, 2022

(Washington, DC) – The District Department of Transportation (DDOT) will temporarily close roadways, lanes, sidewalks, and shoulders to perform construction activities as part of the DC PLUG Feeder 368 project. These closures are contingent on suitable weather, field conditions, and/or adjacent construction activities. Daily closures will take place between 9:30 a.m. and 3:30 p.m.

The parameters for lane and sidewalk closures are as follows:

R Street SE – Single Lane Closure

Single left or right lane closure will occur anytime daily from 9:30 a.m. and 3:30 p.m. going northbound and/or southbound on R St SE between Fort Davis Street SE and Alabama Ave SE.

Easy Place, SE - Single Lane and Sidewalk Closures

Single left or right lane closure will occur anytime daily from 9:30 a.m. and 3:30 p.m. along Easy Place SE between 46th Street SE and Southern Ave SE. We ask that residents and visitors be on the lookout for detour signs as there will also be sidewalk impacts for residents traveling along Easy Place SE.

46th Street, SE - Single Lane and Sidewalk Closures

Single left or right lane closure will occur anytime daily from 9:30 a.m. and 3:30 p.m. along 46th Street SE between Easy Place SE and Bowen Rd SE. We ask that residents and visitors be on the lookout for detour signs as there will also be sidewalk impacts for residents traveling along Easy Place SE.

Alabama Avenue, SE - – Single Lane Closure

Single left or right lane closure will occur anytime daily from 9:30 a.m. and 3:30 p.m. along Alabama Ave SE between R Street SE and Q Street SE.

Alabama Avenue, SE - – Single Lane Closure

Single left or right lane closure will occur anytime daily from 9:30 a.m. and 3:30 p.m. along Alabama Ave SE between 41st and Massachusetts Avenue SE.

Traffic controls will be in place to guide all users of the roadway and sidewalks through the work zones safely. Motorists should expect delays due to the lane closures and are advised to stay alert and be

observant of signage and road work crews while traveling in this area.

These closures are required for construction activities associated with the following DDOT project:

District of Columbia Power Line Undergrounding (DC PLUG)

The District of Columbia Power Line Undergrounding (DC PLUG) initiative is a partnership between the District Department of Transportation (DDOT) and Pepco to improve the resiliency and reliability of the District of Columbia electric system by placing select systems underground. Feeders are primary distribution power lines that provide services to approximately 1,100 residents within a specific neighborhood.
