## **Temporary Westbound and Eastbound Lane, and Sidewalk Closure in the Unit bloc5k, 200 to 500 Blocks of Malcolm X Avenue, SE, For DC PLUG Feeder 15166 Begins September 12, 2024, to October 12, 2024**

**(WASHINGTON, DC)** – The District Department of Transportation (DDOT) advises stakeholders to expect delays due to upcoming lane and sidewalk closures to install manholes, tapholes, conduits, roadway base, milling and paving, and landscaping restoration in the **Unit block, 200 to 500, blocks of Malcolm X, Avenue, SE, between Martin Luther King Jr., Avenue and the 295 Ramp SE**, (weather permitting)

The lane closures are estimated to last **4 weeks** to install manholes, Tapholes, conduits, roadway base, milling, and paving and landscaping restoration. (weather permitting). This work is necessary to complete the DC PLUG initiative's Feeder 15166 project which consists of undergrounding powerlines for a more resilient DC.
