### **Temporary Westbound, Eastbound Lane and Sidewalk Closure from the 200, 400, and 500 Blocks of Newcomb Street, SE, and 4<sup>th</sup> Street, SE For DC PLUG Feeder 15166 Begins June 14, 2024, to July 15, 2024.**

**(WASHINGTON, DC)** – The District Department of Transportation (DDOT) advises stakeholders to expect delays due to upcoming lane and sidewalk closures for Asphalt base restoration on the **200, 400, and 500 blocks of Newcomb Street, SE, and 4<sup>th</sup> Street, SE between 2<sup>nd</sup> Street, SE a Martin Luther King Avenue, SE.** All residents will keep access to their homes. Please adhere to all NO Parking signs.

The lane and sidewalk closure is estimated to last 4 weeks for Asphalt base restoration (weather permitting). The restoration is necessary to complete the DC PLUG initiative's Feeder 15166 project which consists of undergrounding powerlines for a more resilient DC.
