Temporary Southbound and Northbound Lane Closure from the 400 to 600 blocks of Mellon Street, SE, For DC PLUG Feeder 15166 Begins August 11, 2024 to September 11, 2024.

(WASHINGTON, DC) – The District Department of Transportation (DDOT) advises stakeholders to expect delays due to upcoming southbound and northbound lane closures to install manholes, conduits, sidewalk repairs, and asphalt base restoration in the **400 to 600 blocks of Mellon Street, SE between Martin Luther King Jr, Avenue, and 4th Street, SE** (Weather permitting). Installation of manholes, conduits, sidewalk repairs, and asphalt base restoration is necessary to complete the DC PLUG initiative’s Feeder 15166 project which consists of undergrounding powerlines for a more resilient DC.

The lane closures are estimated to last 4 weeks to install manholes, conduits, sidewalk repairs, and asphalt base restoration (weather permitting). Manholes, conduits, and asphalt base restoration are necessary to complete the DC PLUG initiative’s Feeder 15166 project which consists of undergrounding powerlines for a more resilient DC.
