Pepco and DDOT filed a joint Biennial Plan

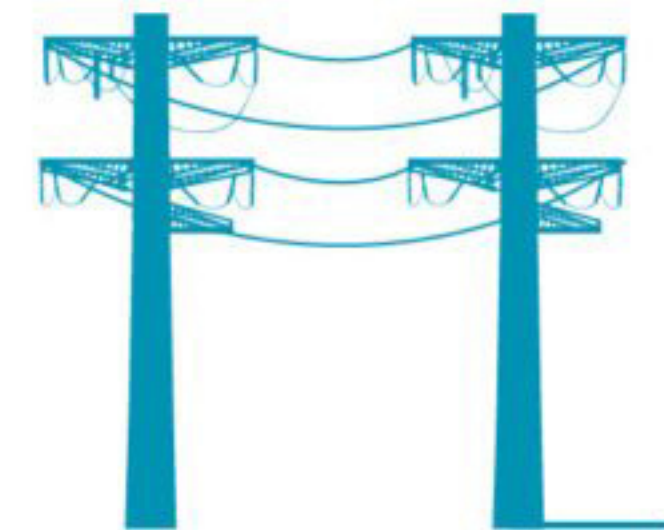
Nov 2017

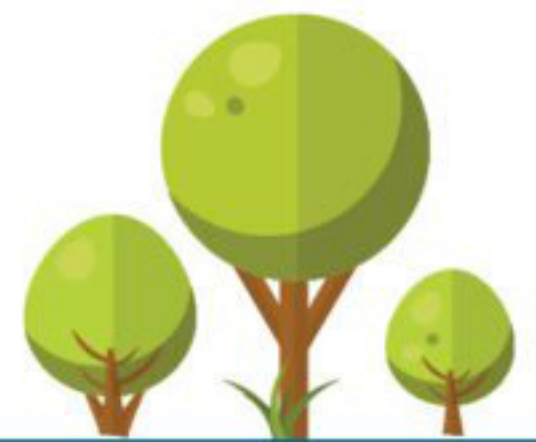

DC PLUG will provide resiliency against major storms and **improve the reliability of the electric system**

The DC PLUG initiative will impact five Wards in D.C. - Wards 3, 4, 5, 7, and 8



Construction is expected to span **6-8 years**, with work beginning in **mid-2018**
